The Offutt School of Business of Concordia College, Moorhead, MN, invites applicants for a full-time faculty position, beginning in August 2022. The teaching assignment is management-related courses in areas including, but not limited to: Principles of Management, Strategic Management, and Supply Chain Management. A familiarity with Organizational Behavior and/or Human Resource Management is also advantageous. Typical class size is 15-25 students. The successful candidate must demonstrate the capability of engaging undergraduate students in active learning of the management discipline, informed by the liberal arts. There is also potential for development of graduate programs. Responsibilities, in addition to classroom teaching, include advising students, serving on faculty committees, and service to the profession and the community. An active research program is required for a tenure-track appointment.

The Offutt School of Business is one of the largest units of the College, offering majors in Accounting, International Business, Finance, and Business Administration (with concentrations in management, marketing, economics, finance). Minors in Accounting, Business, and Entrepreneurship attract growing numbers of students.
